- 2. Children do not need to be associated with a swimming club to register for the event and compete.
- 3. Online entries \$2.50 per event, entry via our website www.windsor.swimming.org.au
- 4. NSW swimming members can enter online through our club Facebook page or our website.
- 5. Swimmers not associated with a club need to email <u>wscracesec@gmail.com</u> with
  - Full name of child
  - Date of birth of child
  - Events the child wishes to swim
- 6. Meet conducted under the rules of and approved by Swimming NSW
- 7. All events are timed finals and a one start rule applies.
- 8. Swimmers may not enter both the 25m and 50m events of the same stroke.
- 9. Entry fee to the pool will be required on the day.
- 10. Age as at 10th February 2019.
- 11. Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all age groups 5 and over. All 25m swimmers in Freestyle will be awarded a participation ribbon.
- 12. Online entries will close on 30th January 2019 or when the limit is reached.
- 13. Programs will be available on the day to purchase for \$3.00.
- 14. A BBQ will be available on the day selling food.
- 15. Limited seating- marquees & chairs welcome. There are plenty of grassed areas.
